



A WORD FROM THE FATHER

We are going to celebrate and experience it again, the coming of Jesus in the flesh. In the beautiful prayer of the Angel of the Lord, we pray with the words of Scripture: The Word became flesh, and dwelt among us." It is at the same time a short confession of faith. Along with the words, Behold the handmaid of the Lord: And she has received of the Holy Ghost, and said, "Behold, the handmaid of the Lord, be it me according to Thy word." Mary emerges as the main character in this Advent season. In addition to the prophet John the Baptist on the three Sundays, first appears on the fourth Sunday. She shares her joy with her cousin Elisabeth in service and the hymn of praise of the Magnificat. "My soul now exalts the Lord on high, and my spirit

delighted with God is mv Redeemer." It is a hymn of praise firmly anchored in that is tradition and writings of its people. It is as if the Lord reveals Himself through her words. He, the Holy Spirit, overshadowed her because his choice fell on his handmaiden. They are rich ones that we can consider again and again. God is looking for people to be present on earth. Thanks to Mary, Jesus was able to open each of us to the secret of the mystery of the Emmanuel, God with us. With these texts, it becomes clear that Mary is also a woman of the word and that Marian devotion has more roots in Holy Scripture than we realize. May the Word also become flesh in us, to the joy of many people who are looking for something to hold on to and maternal warmth.
